Counseling Center

★ Mission

- Primary counseling and mental health agency for students

★ Services

- Individual Counseling (8 sessions/yr)
- Group Counseling (unlimited)
- Psychiatric services/referrals
- Emergency/urgent care
- COACH motivational program
- LGBT mentoring
- Peer educators

Helping Students in Distress

- ★ Step up! What would you want someone to do for you?
- ★ Know how to help:
 - If the student is dangerous to themselves or others: call **UCI Police, 949-824-5223 / 911**
 - If the student is difficult or angry: document incident & refer to **Office of Student Conduct, 949-824-5590**
 - If the student is stressed, emotional or depressed: refer to **Counseling Center, 949-824-6457**

Suicide Prevention: Question, Persuade, Refer

- ★ Counseling Center sees only 10% of student population--many never seek help.
- ★ **Increased risk of suicide:** veterans, international students, LGBT students, high-pressure majors, nurses & dentists
- ★ **Indirect verbal cues:** “I’m tired of life;” “My family would be better off without me;” “It doesn’t matter--I won’t be around much longer.”

Question, Persuade, Refer

- ★ **Question:** Ask in a private setting: Are you thinking of harming yourself?
- ★ **Persuade:** Listen non-judgmentally, express concern, and say “we’ll get you through this.”
- ★ **Refer:** Take them to the Counseling Center yourself, or call together. If student is in immediate danger, call 911.
